
We hope you will join us to celebrate, laugh, learn, fellowship, and share joy with each other.

September 2025


As we study Isaiah's message of repentance and renewal to the Hebrew people, we hope to gain our own understanding of how God moves to bring restoration in the face of brokenness. We've all felt shipwrecked at one time or another; how does God work through the wreckage to shape new life and new hope?



October 2025

Our Stewardship Campaign & October sermon theme is "The Spirit Leads Me..."

During this season, we'll explore the ways the Spirit has led those in our congregation and explore how we can listen for more ways to build the Kingdom of God in Granbury.



November 2025

For the month of November, we are studying the Lord's Prayer.

Our focus in on how Jesus didn't just give us words to recite, but guides us in the way to pray and relate to God.

December 2025 | The Season of Advent

The four weeks leading up to Christmas are the season of Advent.

Each week, we focus on a different theme (hope, joy, love, and peace) and light the candles of the Advent Wreath. This is a season filled with many church traditions like the Christmas Cantata offered by our music ministries, the Children's Pageant & Angel Breakfast, and a candlelight Christmas Eve service.



Angel Breakfast & Nativity Pageant

One of the hallmark traditions of the Christmas Season at FCC is the Angel Breakfast at 9:30 followed by the gift of our Nativity Pageant from our children at a combined 10:30 worship service.

Christmas Cantata

Our Chancel Choir will gift the congregation with their annual Christmas Cantata. This music focused worship service often brings in area musicians to accompany our choir and is a wonderful celebration of music and the season.

Blue Christmas

This season brings with it feelings of hope and joy, excitement and wonder, but it also harbors for many feelings of grief and loneliness, depression and heartache. During this small, simple, quiet, and meditative worship service, we hold space for experiencing the humanity that God has chosen to join us in.

Christmas Eve Candlelight Worship

Another beloved tradition in our church is our candlelight worship service on Christmas Eve. This year we are having a single service for all at 6PM.


